# THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

## PREAMBLE

*WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA*, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a *SOVEREIGN, SOCIALIST, SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC* and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, Social, Economic and Political: *LIBERTY* of thought, expression, belief faith and worship;

Equality of status and of *OPPORTUNITY*; and to promote among them all.

*FRATERNITY* assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the nation.

*IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY* this twenty-sixth day of November; 1949, do *HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.*

## Chapter IV A

### Fundamental Duties

#### *ARTICLE 51A*

Fundamental Duties - It shall be the duty of every citizen of India:

- (a) to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
- (b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom.
- (c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- (d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- (e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic, regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- (f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- (g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, wild life and to have compassion for living creatures;
- (h) to develop a scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- (i) to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- (j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.

## छात्रों के प्रति

प्यारे बच्चों,

भविष्य तुम्हारा है और इसे वर्तमान के द्वारा ही संवारा जा सकता है। इसलिए जिस संसार में तुम रह रहे हो उसमें स्वयं की सक्रिय भागदारी के लिए तथा इसे एक नया स्वरूप देने के लिए अपने को तैयार करें। अतः अपने को एक बुद्धिमान, सभ्य एवं जिम्मेदार नागरिक के रूप में तैयार करो।

यह दैनन्दिनी तुम्हारे अन्दर योजनाबद्ध एवं नियमित रूप से गृहकार्य को करने की आदत विकसित करने के लिए बनाई गई है। तुम्हें यह निर्देश दिया जाता है कि तुम प्रत्येक कालांश में अपने विषयाध्यापक की बातों को ध्यानपूर्वक सुनो और उनके द्वारा गृहकार्य को इसमें लिख लो। घर में अपना कार्य प्रारम्भ करने से पूर्व उन सभी निर्देशों को याद रखो और अपना कार्य बहुत अच्छा करने का प्रयास करो। अपने अभिभावकों की राय में घर में अपनी पढ़ाई के घण्टे निश्चित करो। आज के पाठ की सावधानी से पुनरावृत्ति करो तथा अगले दिन के पाठ की तैयारी करो। भविष्य में यह आदत तुम्हारे लिए लाभदायक सिद्ध होगी।

स्वयं को सर्वोत्तम सिद्ध करने का प्रयास करो। याद रखो कि सदैव सुधार की आवश्यकता बनी रहती है। तुम्हारे घर, विद्यालय एवं देश ने तुम्हें जो भी सुविधाएँ प्रदान की हैं उनका सर्वोत्तम ढंग से लाभ उठाओ। योजनाबद्ध जीवन की आदत अपने अन्दर विकसित करो। आज का काम कल के लिए मत छोड़ो।

## अभिभावकों के लिए

बच्चों के समुचित विकास के लिए अभिभावकों का सहयोग आवश्यक है। आप सुनिश्चित करें कि—

1. बच्चों को आवश्यक सामग्री पुस्तकें, पाठ्य सामग्री तथा गणवेश उपलब्ध कराएँ।
2. बच्चे उचित गणवेश में नियमित रूप से समय पर विद्यालय पहुँचें।
3. बच्चे निर्धारित समय पर विद्यालय शुल्क जमा करा दें।
4. बच्चे अपना गृहकार्य पूरा करने तथा पाठों की पुनरावृत्ति को पर्याप्त समय दें।
5. अभिभावक इस दैनन्दिनी (कलैण्डर) को ध्यानपूर्वक देखें कि बच्चे अपना गृहकार्य नियमित रूप से और सही तरीके से कर रहे हैं या नहीं।
6. अभिभावक किसी अध्यापक और विद्यालय के लिए अपनी ओर से कोई भी टिप्पणी दे सकते हैं। अभिभावकों की राय तथा सुझावों का प्राचार्य सदैव स्वागत करते हैं।
7. अभिभावक अपने बच्चे की प्रगति के विषय में जानने के लिए अपनी सुविधानुसार विषयाध्यापक से मिल सकते हैं।
8. बच्चे के सम्बन्ध में भेजी गई किसी भी सूचना तथा रिपोर्ट के विषय में समयानुसार प्रतिक्रिया व्यक्त कर सकते हैं।
9. अभिभावकों से निवेदन है कि उनके बच्चे विद्यालय में कीमती वस्तुएँ, आभूषण, अधिक धनराशि, मोबाइल फोन इत्यादि न लाएँ।
10. अभिभावक सुनिश्चित करें कि उनके बच्चे सुरक्षित रूप से विद्यालय आएँ तथा वापस घर जाएँ। वे यह भी सुनिश्चित करें कि यदि बच्चा स्कूल बस से स्कूल आता है तो वह सावधानी से आए तथा यातायात के नियमों का पालन करें।
11. कृपया सुनिश्चित करें कि बच्चा स्कूटर / बाइक से स्कूल न आए।
12. कृपया देखें कि बच्चों की स्कूल की साइकिल में ताला हो।
13. बच्चे के कक्षाध्यापक के निरंतर संपर्क में रहें। उनका मोबाइल नं० अवश्य ले लें।
14. अभिभावक बच्चों को विद्यालय के निर्धारित समय पर भेजें और विद्यालय से समय से घर पहुँचे ये सुनिश्चित करें।
15. बच्चों को विद्यालय से लेने उनके अभिभावक समय पर आयें।
16. यदि बच्चा बीमार है, तो उसे स्कूल ना भेजें यथा उपचार करायें।
17. यदि विद्यालय समय के बीच में विद्यार्थी को आवश्यक कार्य हेतु ले जाना है तो केवल अभिभावक ही आएँ अन्यथा उन्हें ले जाने की अनुमति नहीं दी जायेगी।



## To the Parents

Co-operation of parents for the proper development of their wards needs to be emphasized. You are requested to ensure that -

- a) Your wards are provided with necessary books, stationery and uniform' .
- b) They come to school regularly, punctually and in proper uniform'
- c) They pay the school fees and other dues on due date.
- d) They devote sufficient time at home to complete their home-assignments and revise their lessons.
- e) Parents are requested to go through this calendar and check whether their wards are doing their home-task regularly and properly.
- f) Parents are requested to refrain themselves from giving any remark about the position of the school or any teacher. However, they are most welcome to meet the Principal for their opinion and suggestions.
- g) Parents may also meet the subject-teachers concerned at their convenience to get the first hand knowledge of the progress of their wards.
- h) Parents are requested to respond timely to the reports and information sent to them from school.
- i) Parents are requested to see that their wards do not bring costly articles, jewellery, money, mobile phones etc. to school.
- j) Please ensure that your ward is escorted safely to school and back home. Also ensure that he/she travels by the school bus very carefully and follows the rules of travelling.
- k) Please ensure that your ward does not come to school on bike/scooter.
- l) Kindly see that the cycle he/she brings to school should have a lock.
- m) Please be in regular touch with the class teacher of your ward. Keep the mobile no. of the class teacher with you.
- n) Please ensure that your ward arrives at school on time and also reaches back home on time.
- o) Parents to come to school on time to pick up their wards.
- p) If your child is sick, then please don't send him / her to school. Please ensure proper treatment.

8. बूढ़े, कमजोर, बीमार व्यक्तियों तथा छोटे बच्चों की सदा मदद करें।
9. अपने आई कार्ड, स्कूल डायरी एवं रिपोर्ट कार्ड की उपयोगिता समझें एवं संभाल कर रखें। पूछने पर प्रस्तुत करें।
10. दूसरों को उनके अच्छे कार्यों से पहचानना चाहिए न कि बाहरी सुन्दरता से, क्योंकि अच्छा कार्य और व्यवहार ही व्यक्ति की सही पहचान है।

13. अपना पाठ स्वयं पढ़ें, कठिनाइयाँ जाने तथा अध्यापक से समाधान पूछें।
14. प्राचार्य, अध्यापक एवं माता-पिता की आज्ञा का पालन करें।
15. अपने विद्यालय, घर व अपने सामान की देखभाल करें।
16. विद्यालय में पंक्तिबद्ध लाइन में ही जाएँ। सदा बाईं तरफ चलें।
17. उज्ज्वल भविष्य के लिए आज से ही परिश्रम करें।
18. अपना लक्ष्य निर्धारित करें, उसे पाने के लिए परिश्रम करें।
19. किसी भी बुरे व्यक्ति, बात या धारणा के आगे न झुकें।
20. अपनी भाषा, व्यवहार, विचार एवं कार्यों पर काबू रखें जिससे आप पर कोई अँगुली न उठे।
21. सभी बुरी बातों से बचें। न बुरा देखो, न बुरा सुनो और न बुरा बोलो।

## DUTIES OF STUDENTS

1. Acquire knowledge persistently in order to become an educated and cultured citizen.
2. Be accurate in taking down notes, assignments for home work and schedules for the next lessons. Attempt home work unaided and keep parents well-informed about the School assignments
3. Cherish the honour of the Nation, school, family and your own defend it by your deeds, work and training.

4. Desist from the use of coarse expression, bad language and all such activities which may affect self-honour & image
5. Reach the classroom immediately after the bell rings. During the lesson, enter or leave the class room only when it is urgent and that too, with the teacher's permission and with an out-pass.
6. Feel happy by being well-groomed and neatly dressed.
7. Greet fellow students, teachers, Principal and elders with polite salutations. Be respectful to everyone.
8. Help the old, weak, sick and small children.
9. Inculcate the habit of keeping your Library Card, School Diary and Progress Report Card carefully and produce them whenever required.
10. Judge others not by their looks but by their work, manners and helpful nature.
11. Keep your surroundings neat and tidy.
12. Lay aside laziness and launch a campaign for punctuality.
13. Maintain order and cleanliness at home and in the classroom.
14. Note down your difficulties and be ready for the lesson before the teacher arrives.
15. Obey the instructions of the Principal and teachers of the School as well as of one's parents and seniors.
16. Protect School property and belongings of others and self.
17. Queue up while awaiting your turn or when moving in the corridors of the School.
18. Remember to stand up when a teacher, the Principal or a visitor enters or leaves the room.
19. Sit upright in the class. It helps to concentrate on the lesson. Do not lean on the elbows or slouch.
20. Toil hard today as the student life is the only period to shape your destiny.
21. Underscore your goals and set your priorities and channelize all your energies towards their accomplishment.
22. Watch your words, actions and your thoughts so that no finger is pointed at you.
23. Yield the best in the worst circumstances as every experience teaches you something good.
24. Zap all the negative emotions as they are your own enemies.

## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- (a) The following acts and conduct on the part of the students will amount to misconduct :
- (i) Misbehaviour towards teachers or any other employee of the school.
  - (ii) Intentional disturbance of classes.
  - (iii) Absence from classes without the permission of the teacher / Vice-Principal / Principal.
  - (iv) Bullying / intimidation of others.
  - (v) Eve-teasing/misbehaviour towards girl-students.
  - (vi) Damaging/disfiguring school property.
  - (vii) Propagating a strike / disruption of classes.
  - (viii) Association with banned organizations.
  - (ix) Propagating communal / caste feeling amongst the students.
  - (x) Indulging in physical violence in any manner.
  - (xi) Disobeying lawful orders of the teacher / Vice-Principal / Principal
  - (xii) Bringing unauthorized people / articles inside the school.
  - (xiii) Theft / pilferage of school / students' property.
  - (xiv) Any behaviour unbecoming of a student.
  - (xv) Indulging in acts of moral turpitude.
- (b) In above acts of misconduct, Principal shall take suitable action as per observations of the disciplinary committee depending on the gravity of the misconduct, which may include
- (i) Oral / written warnings to the student and parents.
  - (ii) Suspension from attending classes/school for a specified period.
  - (iii) Recovery of loss to school property.
  - (iv) Issue of Transfer Certificate.
  - (v) Expulsion / rustication from school.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Vidyalaya is run by Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan under the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Education with an endeavour to facilitate education of children of Central Government Employees, Defence Personnel and employees of autonomous bodies who are liable to be transferred from one state to another state to receive uninterrupted educational facilities with easy accessibility to any Kendriya Vidyalaya in any part of the country.

The school embodies some of the good features of Public Schools with emphasis on Indian culture and values without raising the cost of education.

### MEDIUM

The medium of instruction is bilingual. Mathematics and Science subjects are taught through English language and Social Studies through Hindi as well as English Language.

### AFFILIATION

The Vidyalaya is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi and prepares students for All India Secondary School (Class X Examination and All India Senior Certificate (Class XII) Examination of the Board.

### ACADEMIC YEAR

The Academic year is from 1st April to 31st March.

### ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- (a) A child must be at least 5 years old on 31st March in the academic year in which admission is being sought for admission to Class I, Class II, Class III, and Class IV. For subsequent Classes the eligible age would be reckoned again with reference to 30th September with a proportionate increase over 5 Years.
- (b) An upper age limit for admission is fixed as the minimum age limit plus 2

### METHOD OF ADMISSION

**For classes I to VIII** - No admission test would be conducted for admission to classes I to VIII. All applications received would be divided into five categories in order of priority to the extent vacancies are available. For admission to Class IX except X, XI & XII an admission test would be conducted and a merit list prepared for each category of priority separately.

### SPECIAL PROVISION FOR ADMISSION FOR SINGLE GIRL CHILD

#### (1) ADMISSION CLASS - I

After admitting the candidates up to full intake capacity as per norms, if there are single female children left among the unsuccessful applicants, up to two single female children may be admitted in each section of class - I over and above the class strength for admission under special provisions. For selection on this basis, inter se priority among such single female children shall be as per the categorization given in the Admission Guidelines.

#### (2) ADMISSION IN CLASSES - VI ONWARDS

Single female children of employees coming under categories I-V may be admitted up to a maximum of two girls per class over and above the class strength for admissions under special provisions. In the event of there being more than two such applicants for a class, selection will be based on inter se priority for different categories as given in the Admission Guidelines.

### ATTENDANCE

For the successful implementation of the academic Programme regular & punctual attendance is essential.

#### THEREFORE

- (a) A student should obtain prior permission of the class teacher for not attending the classes. If previous permission is not obtained due to unavoidable circumstances, an application for leave should be sent to the class teacher the same day or latest by next day.
- (b) All applications for leave are to be signed by the parent.
- (c) Applications for leave on medical ground are to be supported by an authentic medical certificate.
- (d) Student suffering from infectious disease will not be allowed to attend the classes or to appear in the examination.
- (e) If the attendance is less than the prescribed percentage i.e. 75% of the total working days (including attendance put in a previous school, If the student has been admitted on transfer) the student will not be allowed to appear at the Annual Examination.
- (d) A prolonged absence (without application for leave) for ten consecutive days will result in the removal of the name from the rolls.

### CONDONATION

A minimum of 75% of the total attendance of the academic session would be necessary to appear at the Annual Examination. In case of genuine illness, if supported with Medical Certificate from a Government Hospital or on account of- Participation in Vidyalaya / Inter - Vidyalaya activities or any other reason beyond the control of the student, the authority concerned shall be competent to condone shortage of attendance.

**PROMOTION RULES :-**

- 1) For classes I & II promotion is to be decided as per existing system of eight cycle assessment.
- 2) For classes III – VIII students scoring E grade will be given one chance to improve their performance before 15.04.2019.
- 3) For promotion in class IX, a student has to pass separately in internal assessment and external exam / assessment by securing at least 33% marks separately. If a student fails in two subjects she/he will be placed in compartment provided he/she qualifies in internal assessment of all the subjects. (ANNEXURE-I)
- 4) For class XI. (refer KVS HQ letter F. 110331-01/2017-KVS/Acad/CBSE/264-99 dated 31.05.2017).
  - a. The examination for class XI would be conducted in theory as well as in practical / project, depending upon the nature of the subject(s) and the marks allotted shall be as prescribed in the curriculum.
  - b. The qualifying marks in each subject of external examination shall be 33%. However, in a subject involving practical/project work, a candidate must obtain 33% marks (in cumulative manner) in the theory and 33% marks in the practical / project separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate, in order to qualify in that subject.
  - c. In order to be declared as having passed the class XI Examination, a candidate shall obtain 33% in all the subjects (without additional subject). The pass marks in each subjects of examination shall be 33%. In case of subject involving practical/project work a candidate must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% in practical/project separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate in order to qualify in that subject.
  - d. A candidate failing in one of the five subjects of examination at class XI shall be placed in Compartment in that subject provided he/she qualifies in all the subjects of internal assessment (As per CBSE Examination Byelaws Notification 29.11.2016 regarding Additions/Amendments in Examination Bye-Laws, Para 4.

- e. A candidate has to appear mandatorily in Session Ending Examination to be eligible to be considered for promotion to class XII.
- f. The student has to appear in all the examinations to be declared pass/promoted.
- g. No re-exam shall be conducted except on genuine grounds including medical.
- h. A total of 10 grace marks spread all over the subject with a maximum of 04 marks in one subject can be given to a students who has participated in the KVS National Meet / SGFI Meet in that Academic Year. These marks can be given in the column of final weighted score to the extent needed to promote the student and not to bring him/her in the zone of supplementary case.

5) Supplementary Examination for IX / XI will be held in the first fortnight of April.

#### **FEE AND OTHER CONCESSIONS :**

1.) No fee to be charged from the children admitted under the 25% quota prescribed under RTE Act 2009 2.) One set of NCERT text books for his/her class to each child will be provided by the school and other expenses on account of note books, stationary, uniform and transport will be reimbursed on production of proper bills in respect of 25% of the children admitted under the Act subject to the ceiling prescribed. 3.) Once the children are admitted in class I under RTE Act. they will continue to enjoy exemptions and concessions till class VIII either in the same KV or any other K.V. moving on transfer as per RTE Act. 4.) Address proof of the parent should be furnished at the time of the registration. 5.) The employees who have the facility of fee reimbursement in their departments cannot claim RTE concessions.

#### **ADMISSION / RE -ADMISSION FEE :**

An Admission Fee of Rs. 25/- shall be paid at the time of fresh admission to the school' An Admission Fee of Rs. 25/- is also charged on for transfer from other Kendriya Vidhaylaya. Re-Admission Fee Rs. 100/- for names struck off due to any reason.

### **FINE :**

A fine of Rs. 5/-per day for VVN and Rs. 5/-per day on tuition fee will be charged up to last working day & after which the name shall be struck off the roll due to non payment of dues & Re-admission will be done on payment of Rs. 100/-along with late payment fine.

For classes IX to XII in respect of the students who are required to deposit the Fees in addition to VVN in case of late deposit of tuition fees VVN fee fine / higher contribution to be charged separately @ 5/. per day in both tuition fees & VVN are deposited late, the fees & higher contributions will be Rs. 10/- per day. The name of the child is to be restored only after charging late fees fine both tuition fees & VVN + Re Admission Fees

### **SCHOOL LIBRARY & READING ROOM**

Each child is expected to make full use of the library & the reading room. He / She shall get one book at a time for one week on his / her card. He / She may be allowed to have two books at a time on special recommendation of the class teacher. Children shall observe the rules of the library Reading Room as enforced from time to time. If a student fails to return the book loaned to him within the due date, a fine at the Rate of 1/- book per week from the date of return shall be levied in the case of wilful delay only. They should keep the library card safe & take it back when they return the book. A second card shall be issued only on payment of Rs. 1/- as a fine. This money will be deposited in the Pupil Fund.
